



Instructions to Presenters

Type of Presentations

The ISSWSH Annual Meeting 2026 will feature three types of **Oral Presentations**:

1. **Oral Presentations (Best Abstracts Session):** will be granted 8 minutes to present, followed by 4 minutes discussion.
2. **Oral Presentations (Research Podium Session):** will be granted 6 minutes to present, followed by 4 minutes discussion.
3. **Video Presentations (Journal Session):** will be granted an 8-minute video, followed by 2 minutes discussion.

The ISSWSH Annual Meeting 2026 will feature two types of **E-Posters**:

- **Discussed E-Poster Presentations:** will be displayed as digital e-posters on poster stations and will be granted a 2-minute presentation, followed by 1 minute discussion during one of the dedicated e-poster sessions.
- **Non-Discussed E-Posters** will be displayed as digital e-posters on poster stations.

Oral Presentations

If you are presenting an Oral Presentation, please observe the following points:

- All Speakers are required to begin their presentation with a Disclosure/Conflict of Interest slide.
- All Disclosures/Conflicts of interest which are relevant to your presentation **MUST** be stated out loud, whilst the slide is visible to the audience.
- Please note that only digital Microsoft PowerPoint for Windows or digital video files (MP4, MOV, AVI) are possible. Mac-based presentations must be converted for PC use.
- We recommend that you use the latest version of Microsoft PowerPoint for Windows to develop your presentation. If you are using embedded video clips in your presentation, please ensure that this file is included in your PowerPoint file or include/submit your video files separately (we recommend saving a copy of the original video file with your PowerPoint presentation just in case).
- Slides must be submitted to the staff in the meeting room at least 2 hours prior to the session. You can bring your PowerPoint slides on a flash drive (preferably in the ratio of 16:9). It will not be permitted to connect your own personal notebook.
- We recommend that you store an accessible copy of your presentation in the cloud (e.g. webmail, dropbox, Google drive, etc.).

Video Presentations

If you are presenting a Video Presentation, please observe the following points:

- Maximum duration of the video: 8 minutes.
- Videos must have English captions or narration.
- Please ensure that your videos protect patient anonymity and integrity.
- The preferred resolution is 1280x720p (16:9 aspect ratio) HD video.
- Acceptable file formats are mp4, avi and mpeg4.
- Please submit your final video to the staff in the meeting room at least 2 hours prior to the session.

Important Notice

The organization is seeking for accreditation by the American Medical Association (AMA) to provide continuing medical education (CME) credits to physicians. The ACCME has implemented a regulation for abstract submissions.



Therefore, the (oral) abstract presenter is required to:

Discussed E-poster Presentations

Discussed e-poster presentations will be granted a 2-minute presentation, followed by 1 minute for discussion during one of the dedicated e-poster sessions. During your 2-minute presentation, we will display your poster on the screen. Note that PowerPoint presentations will not be accepted for these sessions. We advise you to use the template poster file when creating your poster. However, note that all e-posters need to be in landscape format with aspect ratio of 16:9 and saved as high resolution files (minimal 1920x1080 pixels). [Click here to download the template.](#)

In order to give all participants, the opportunity to view all posters without any hurry, all posters will be published at digital poster stations during the meeting and on the official meeting website. Please submit a digital version of your poster by sending the file to meeting@isswsh.org or by uploading the file via <https://isswsh.wetransfer.com/> before **January 29, 2026**. Please note that you do not have to bring a hard copy of the poster.

Non-discussed E-posters
